- Pulmonic — 3 factors
 - Place
 - Manner
 - Voiced/Voiceless
- Non-Pulmonic — 2 factors
 - Place
 - Manner

rarely appears
- Co-articulated
 - two simultaneous places articulate

[aɪ p^hi: eɪ]

Diacritics

Extend and adjust consonants and vowels.

Suprasegmentals

Indicate relation between segments

Tones

Indicate rise and fall of word or sentence.
